



Supplementary Rules & Information

Test & Tune Meeting Hampton Downs Motorsport Park 26th & 27th September 2020

This is a single event run over a period of two days. This event is for all levels of drivers who either currently compete in Road Racing & wish to Test & Tune up their karts. Or Complete Novices just wanting to try out Road Racing for the first time.

There will be tutorial from KSNZ Technical Officer on Scrutineering of Karts & will be available to answer any technical questions regarding Superkarting, KSNZ Officials will be there to oversee & advise drivers on driving standards, gear standards & will endeavour to answer any questions regarding Superkarting.

Trade Shops will be there to assist in any way they can whether it is gearing, set up or supplying of parts should you require them. The Club will endeavour to also have all class representatives at this meeting & they will be another avenue of advice & support to you.

1. Entry Details

Entries must be on the official entry form & accompanied by correct fees.

2. Licence Rating

Minimum licence rating – KSNZ nil – drivers that do not have a KSNZ Licence will be required to acquire a Have a Go Trade Licence from either Urban Performance or Westspeed Motorsport Limited. Paperwork for this will be at the track on Saturday and Sunday morning. (Additional Charge of \$10.00 for Have a Go Licence).

ALL NEW DRIVER's MUST HAVE AN 'X' Plate ON THE BACK OF THEIR KART

3. Drivers Briefing

Will be conducted on Saturday & Sunday in the out-grid area or other such place that will be notified. All drivers & signed in parents/legal guardians are required to attend drivers briefing each day.

4. No Go Line

Is the end of pit lane where it meets the track; or as otherwise advised at drivers briefing.

5. Dummy Grid

This will be in the official car dummy grid area.

6. Control Tower/Infield

These areas are out of bounds except for event officials. **There Will Be A Recovery Vehicle.**

7. Noise Control

No kart engines may be started before 8.00am. A noise meter may be in use.

8. Refuelling

Refuelling on the grid or track is not permitted. Any competitor without their own fire extinguisher when using the pit/garage areas are to make themselves fully aware of the nearest fire extinguisher point to be used in case of emergency.

9. Flags & Lights

Kartsport New Zealand Rule H 1.17 will apply.

MSNZ procedures / meanings for Flags and Lights are not identical to those used for Sprint Events. Superkart Competitors must be familiar with the Flags / Lights Section in the MSNZ Manual - Appendix 4 - Schedule Z

I declare that I will not make use of drugs or of prohibited methods such as are defined by the Intoxicating Liquor and Drug regulations of KartSport New Zealand. I declare that I give consent to the details contained on this entry form being held by KartSport New Zealand and/or the Organising Club for the purpose of the promotion and benefit of the event concerned and KartSport in general. I acknowledge my right to access and correction of this information. This consent is given in accordance with the Privacy Act 1993.
